Community Asset Transfer (CAT) involves transferring responsibility for an asset to a community-led organisation. It can include the community taking on:

> OUTRIGHT OWNERSHIP A LEASE OTHER MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES

Community control of land and buildings is a great way for communities to make good things happen. Taking control of an asset can provide: A BASE FOR ACTIVITIES AND SERVICES NEW ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES IMPROVED HEALTH AND WELLBEING A MORE ATTRACTIVE ENVIRONMENT
