NEW PLANS FOR A CYCLE PATH ARE UNDERWAY BUT WHERE WILL IT GO?

After last year's laying down and digging up of the dual cycle path along Holmston Road, South Ayrshire Council in association with Ayrshire Roads Alliance are once again in the process of planning a new cycle path from Ayr Train Station to Holmston Roundabout.

IN EXCESS OF £1 MILLION HAS BEEN SET ASIDE FOR THIS.

It is the opinion of Forehill, Holmston & Masonhill Community Council (FHMCC) that this WILL go ahead as part of the Council's commitment to 'provide alternative environmentally friendly travel routes, while promoting healthy, active lifestyles'.

HOWEVER, WE NEED TO ENSURE WE CAN HAVE OUR SAY ON WHERE IT GOES.

Both routes preferred by South Ayrshire Council - one initially along the north and one along the south side of the river Ayr - have options to exit onto Holmston Road **OR** behind Holmston Crescent/Kilnbank Crescent, on to Overmills Road then onto Holmston Road.

Further decisions about where it will go are to be made by the SAC during Spring'18.
