Notes

1. The overall crime picture is positive but in respect of the areas reported on Assaults have unfortunately increased on last year whilst breaches of the peace have reduced, the detection rate is particularly high with regard to these crime types.
2. Housebreakings and car crime in the Ayr East ward again had no reports. Residents must remain vigilant during the spring months, there have been some opportunist crimes in other areas of Ayr to houses, sheds and cars and gardening equipment can become a target at this time of year. The detections rates for these crimes remain quite low and anyone seen acting suspiciously should be reported to police immediately to assist in catching those responsible.
3. A request was made at some of the Community Council meetings for crime comparison with North & East Ayrshire, for specific crime levels but this is very difficult as finding similar ward or localities to meaningfully compare. In general crime levels are lower in South Ayrshire than elsewhere.
